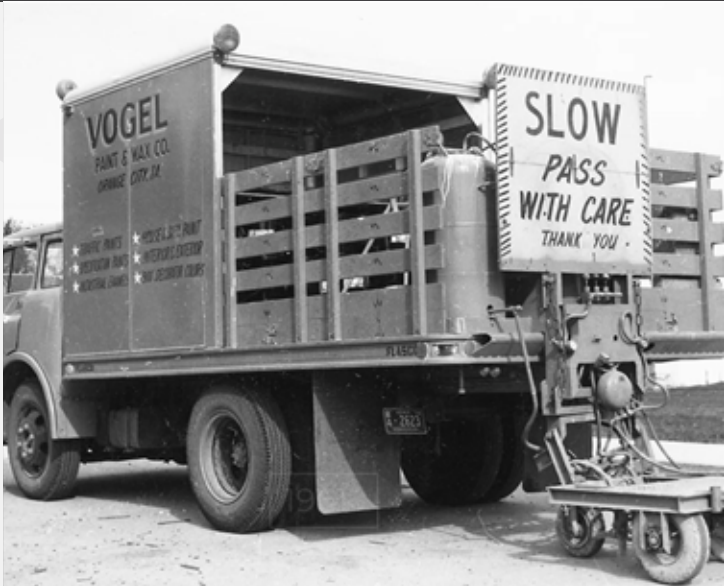

Our History

In the early 1960s in Orange City, Iowa, Vogel Paint began building highway marking equipment for its road paint crews. By 1965, the EZ Liner brand emerged. By the late 1970s, manufacturing stripers had become a full-time business, producing and selling hundreds of models each year. This soon expanded to include pickup, palletized, and truck-mounted paint strippers.

Arrow Striping began in 1993 in Billings, Montana, focusing on pavement striping and removal. In 2016, Arrow shifted to designing and producing pavement marking and removal equipment. In 2023, EZ Liner acquired Arrow to broaden both companies' product lines and better serve the industry.

Automated Raised Pavement Marker Trucks

Delivering a safer, more efficient method of marker application, the Automated RPM Truck has been road-tested and refined to meet EZ Liner – Arrow's high standards for quality, durability, and reliability.



The operator controls the bituminous drop puddle and marker placement using a custom-designed timer system and in-cab control screen. Markers are loaded and stored in a carousel on the deck and fed to the applicator carriage via timing system, which ensures accurate placement on the pavement. Designed for continuous motion, this system minimizes vehicle wear while maximizing safety and efficiency.

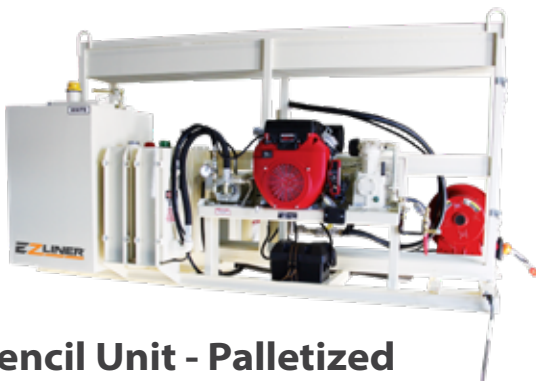

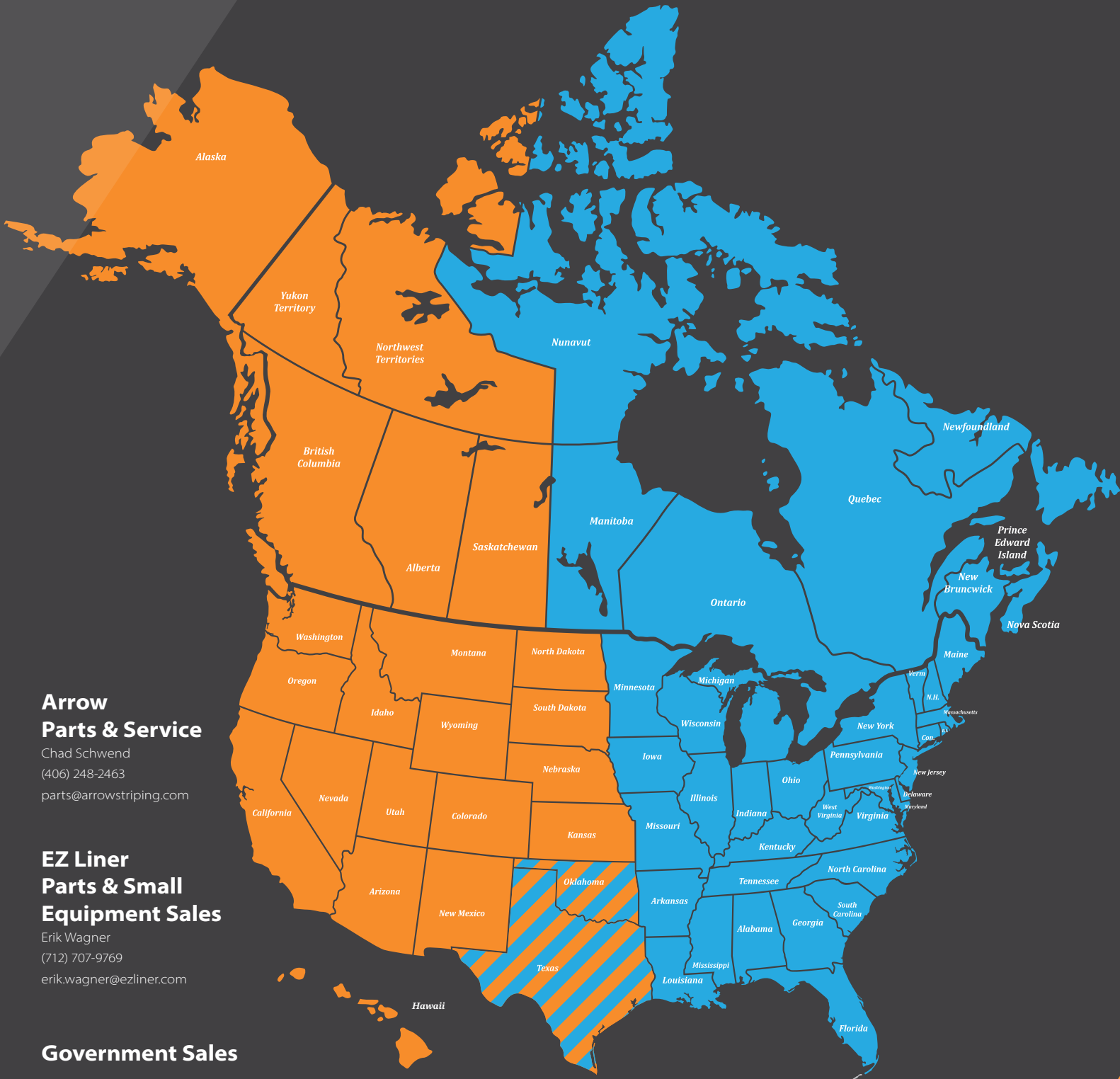
